

## Requirements and Responsibilities for Membership

### DUTIES

- Responds to alarms; performs firefighter duties including, but not limited to, the use of hoses, pumps, equipment, emergency apparatus, and tools.
- Follows standard policies, procedures, guidelines, and safety rules.
- Participates in fire drills, and attends classes to attain and maintain necessary skills.
- Maintains, checks, test, and repairs apparatus, equipment and facilities as assigned.
- Participates in community activities, public education, standbys, fire watches, station tours, and other events that require public interaction.

### MINIUMUM REQUIREMENTS

- Must be at least 18 years of age or older at the time of application. Persons ages 16 to 18 may be allowed to participate as support upon approval of the station Fire Chief.
- Must be a resident of Skagit County Fire Protection District No 5 or be approved by the station chief.
- Must meet the Fire Department minimum medical and health requirements.
- Must have a high school diploma or equivalent. Students shall be in good standing with at school and maintain at minimum a 3.0 GPA.
- Must possess a valid Driver's license or Identification card.
- Applicant's traffic record is subject to review and approval.
- Have not been convicted of felony or disqualifying criminal history.
- Must meet minimum physical entrance requirements.
